

Chevy Colorado 2023 - Current Rear Install Directions

NOTE: Park on level surface for installation. As you progress with the install, check that the mudflap remains square and plumb to the tire.

Included hardware:


8- #8 x 1.125 (SSBO) screws; 8- (SSBO) #10 washers; 2 - small u-clips just in case; 2- Flat clips #10016.


- **Step 1:** Remove mud flaps from package. Smooth side faces rear, tapered corner on top is outside top edge. Rain grooves face the tire.
- Step 2: Attach the flat clip to the back (smooth) side of the mudflap at Point A. Use a #8 x 1.25 (SSBO) screw thru the (SSBO) #10 washer, thru the tire side of the mudflap (side with grooves), into the U-clip. Leave loose for now. See picture on the back.


Note: If in place, remove the factory splash guard.

- Step 3: Remove screws at points B, C and D, be careful not to break the u-clips on the liner.
- Note: If needed, longer screws have been supplied. If you break a u-clip there are replacement u-clips included in the hardware.
- **Step 4:** Align hole B in the mud flap with the factory hole **B** and secure with the factory screw and washer. Leave slightly loose.
- **Step 5:** Repeat step 4 at Hole C & D.
- **Step 6:** Slide the "FLAT CLIP" under the edge of the fender well lip, and tighten causing the clip to grip the fender well firmly at Point A.
- **Step 7:** Check alignment and tighten all screws and bolts.
